

Martin is Chairman of the Bankruptcy group at Proskauer Rose LLP, after being at Weil, Gotshal & Manges LLP as head of the bankruptcy department and a member of its Management Committee. Martin also teaches Corporate Reorganization at Harvard Law School and University of Michigan Law School. Martin leads the representation of the Financial Oversight and Management Board for Puerto Rico in restructuring all governmental debt and restoring fiscal responsibility.
