

Clifford J. White III is the former head of the Justice Department's United States Trustee Program (USTP), known as the "watchdog" of the bankruptcy system. Before retiring in 2022, Cliff served as the USTP's Director for 17 years. During his tenure, the USTP objected to non-consensual third-party releases, including in the *Purdue Pharma* case which was decided by the Supreme Court in favor of the government's position. Cliff received two Presidential Rank Awards which are the highest awards given to career government senior executives. Cliff is currently employed by a financial technology and services firm. He continues to speak and write on bankruptcy topics.
