Stephen B. Rubin, retired New Jersey Superior Court Judge and former Hunterdon County Prosecutor, is Of Counsel to The Rotolo Law Firm, where he focuses on alternative dispute resolutions offering opportunities for the Firm's clients to resolve their legal issues outside of traditional courtroom litigation. Stephen Rubin has in excess of 45 years of experience in a distinguished legal career. He was appointed to the bench in 2002, where he served as a New Jersey Superior Court Judge until his retirement in 2015. During this tenure, Mr. Rubin was responsible for resolving thousands of cases in every division of State Superior Court, including criminal, civil, family and probate. This appointment was preceded by Mr. Rubin's term as Prosecutor for Hunterdon County, where he served from 1997 through 2002. Before that, Mr. Rubin spent 27 years in private practice in Flemington, NJ.

Throughout his career, Mr. Rubin held several positions including Special Deputy Attorney General; Hunterdon County Assistant and First Assistant Prosecutor; Prosecutor for Flemington, Raritan, Union and Alpha; attorney for Raritan Township Board of Health; Planning Board attorney for Holland Township and Bloomsbury Township; and township attorney for Delaware Township.

Mr. Rubin is a 1966 graduate of Rutgers University and a 1969 graduate of Seton Hall University School of Law. Upon receipt of his law degree, Mr. Rubin served as law clerk to the Hon. Thomas J. Beetel, J.S.C.

His professional affiliations include membership in both the New Jersey State Bar Association and the Hunterdon County Bar Association; the New Jersey Supreme Court Committees for Family Law Practice, Criminal Rules of Evidence, Fee Arbitration (District XIII), and Ethics (District XIII); the New Jersey Parole Advisory Board; and the New Jersey Municipal Prosecutors Association.

In addition, Mr. Rubin maintains an active involvement in his community, including having served as Chairman of the Hunterdon County Israel Bond Drive, a Trustee of the Hunterdon County Central High School Foundation, and past President of the Flemington Jewish Community Center and the Flemington Lions Club.
