Judge Carey was first appointed to the Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania in 2001, and, since 2005, has served on the Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (as chief judge from 2008-2011). Judge Carey is on the Executive Committee of the Board of the American Bankruptcy Institute and serves as Vice President of Membership. He is a past Global Chairman of the Turnaround Management Association. Judge Carey is a member of the National Conference of Bankruptcy Judges and also serves as an associate editor for the American Bankruptcy Law Journal. He is the Third Circuit representative on the Administrative Office's Bankruptcy Judges Advisory Group and a member of the Third Circuit Judicial Council's Facilities and Security Committee. He is a contributing author to Collier on Bankruptcy and Collier Forms Manual. Judge Carey is also a part-time adjunct professor in the LL.M. in Bankruptcy program at St. John's University School of Law in New York City, New York and at Temple University's Beasley School of Law in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. He began his legal career in 1979 as law clerk to Bankruptcy Judge Thomas M. Twardowski, and then served as Clerk of Court of the Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania. Judge Carey received his J.D. in 1979 from the Villanova University School of Law and his B.A. in 1976 from The Pennsylvania State University.
