She is a national Regional Criminal Coordinator for the United States Trustee Program and a member of the Bankruptcy Fraud and Mortgage Fraud Task Forces, hosted by the Office of the United States Attorney. Martha is a frequent lecturer at the National Bankruptcy Training Institute for the Department of Justice, professional organizations, and the Bankruptcy Inn of Court.
